







### Quick Reference Legend

*OPT* Enter in OPT column  
*COM* Enter in COMMAND line


## Scrolling through a Report

<i>BOTTOM</i>	Scrolls to the bottom of the current page. <i>COM</i>
<i>COL</i>	Sets the starting column on the screen. <i>COM</i>
<i>DOWN</i>	Scrolls down a specified number of lines. <i>COM</i>
<i>LEFT</i>	Scrolls left a specified number of columns. <i>COM</i>
<i>PAGE</i>	Scrolls to a specified page number or the next page. <i>COM</i>
<i>RIGHT</i>	Scrolls right a specified number of columns. <i>COM</i>
<i>TOP</i>	Scrolls to the top of the current page. <i>COM</i>
<i>UP</i>	Scrolls up a specified number of lines. <i>COM</i>
	Turns on/off the Ruler line.
	Scrolls up the number of lines specified in the Scroll field.
	Scrolls down the number of lines specified in the Scroll field.
	Scrolls left a full screen.
	Scrolls right a full screen.
	Scrolls down to the next page.

## Scroll Field Entries

1-9999	Specifies the number of lines to scroll.
CSR	Cursor - Scrolls to the line or column containing the cursor.

## Printing a Report

<i>CAN</i>	Cancels a print command. <i>COM</i>
<i>PRT</i>	Prints a displayed report or a report from the list of reports. If CONFIRM PRINT REQUEST is set to NO, will not display the P06/P07 print screen. <i>OPT</i> or <i>COM</i>
<i>P?</i>	Prints a report from the list of reports. Always displays the P06/P07/P14 print screen. <i>OPT</i>
	Prints a report while displayed. If CONFIRM PRINT REQUEST is set to NO, will not display the P06/P07/P14 print screen.

## Permanent Views

<i>AV</i>	Adds a view definition to a report. <i>COM</i>
<i>B</i>	Displays the report with the view applied from the V17 screen. <i>OPT</i>
<i>CAN</i>	Cancels a view definition. <i>COM</i>
<i>DEL</i>	Deletes a view definition. <i>OPT</i>
<i>LV</i>	Lists the available views for a displayed report. <i>COM</i>
<i>PRT/P?</i>	Prints the report with the view applied. <i>OPT</i> or <i>COM</i>
<i>RV</i>	Resets or releases the view definition. <i>COM</i>
<i>S</i>	Edits an existing view from the V17 screen. <i>OPT</i>
<i>SV</i>	Invokes a view definition for a displayed report. <i>COM</i>
<i>V</i>	Lists the available views for a report from the V06 screen. <i>OPT</i>

## Permanent View Fields

<i>View Name</i>	1-8 character name entered with AV command.
<i>View Description</i>	40 character detail description of view.
<i>Report Title 1</i>	60 character line that displays on first line of report.
<i>Report Title 2</i>	60 character line that displays on second line of report.
<i>Header Hold</i>	Lines that do not participate in the scroll process.
<i>Columns</i>	Limits the display of a series of column pairs. Also, freezes columns on left side of screen that do not scroll.
<i>Lines</i>	Limits the display of a series of line pairs.
<i>Context</i>	Sets the scope of the Find command.
<i>Scroll</i>	Sets the scroll field value or CSR.
<i>Visual Bar</i>	Sets row of characters inserted between prescribed number of lines.
<i>Index Display</i>	Applies index name to the view.
<i>Initial Cmd</i>	Command automatically executed when view is invoked.
<i>Apply to Print</i>	If view is available to print.
<i>Default View</i>	If view is automatically invoked when report is displayed.

### Creating a Temporary View

<i>HDR</i>	Freezes lines at top of screen that do not scroll. <i>COM</i>
<i>RV</i>	Resets the display and releases all command specifications. <i>COM</i>
<i>SC</i>	Sets a series of column pairs to display. Also, freezes columns on left side of screen that do not scroll. <i>COM</i>
<i>SL</i>	Sets a series of line pairs to display. <i>COM</i>
<i>TL1</i>	Displays a title line on the first line of a report. <i>COM</i>
<i>TL2</i>	Displays a title line on the second line of a report. <i>COM</i>
<i>VB</i>	Displays a row of special characters inserted between a prescribed number of lines. <i>COM</i>

### Finding Text

<i>CONTEXT</i>	Sets the scope of the Find command. <i>COM</i>
<i>F</i>	Searches for a prescribed string of text. <i>COM</i>
<b>F5</b>	Repeats the last Find command.

### Keystrokes

<b>EOF</b> or <b>End</b>	Erases from the cursor to the end of the field. (Keyboard must be mapped.)
<b>Home</b>	Moves cursor to the Command line.
<b>Tab</b>	Moves cursor to the next field.
<b>Shift</b> + <b>Tab</b>	Moves cursor to the previous field.

<b>F2</b>	Ruler
<b>F3</b>	End
<b>F4</b>	Print
<b>F5</b>	Find
<b>F6</b>	Context
<b>F7</b>	Up
