
After the installation is complete, click "Finish" to exit the installation.

To establish an eVPN connection:

1. Start the CISCO AnyConnect Mobility Client (VPN Connect).
2. Click on the “Windows Start Button” in the lower left corner of your desktop and choose “All Programs.”
3. Click on the “Cisco” folder.
4. Click on the “Cisco AnyConnect Secure Mobility Client” folder.
5. Click on the “Cisco AnyConnect Secure Mobility Client” to start the VPN Client.
6. Once the CISCO AnyConnect Secure Mobility Client opens, enter the following url in the white box next to the connect button as shown below:



Click "Connect" to continue.



If the URL was entered correctly, you will be presented with Cisco authentication. Enter the same username and password that you were given for access to the HHS Enterprise Portal. Click "OK."

The warning message will include the user's rights while connected., and must be accepted to continue.



Select "Accept" to complete your VPN connection.
